Caesarscreek Township's population has decreased overall since 1980.

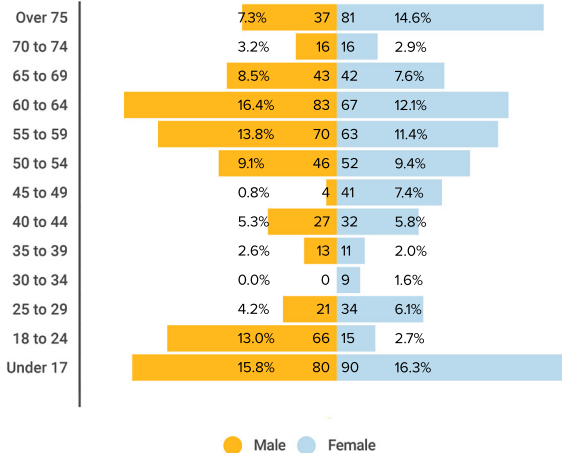

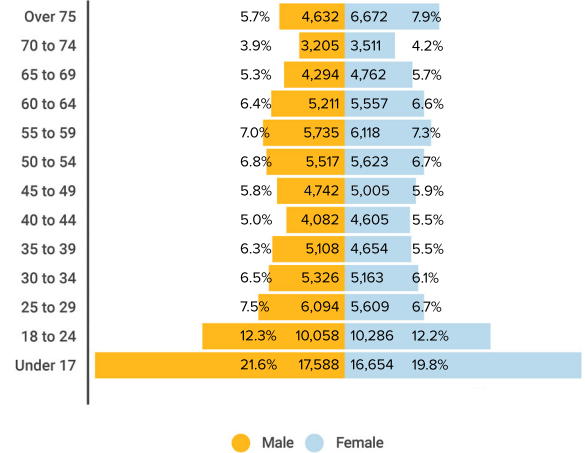
## Population Sex by Age

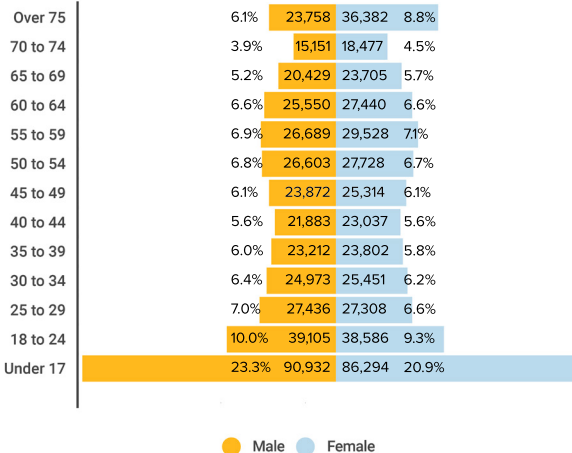

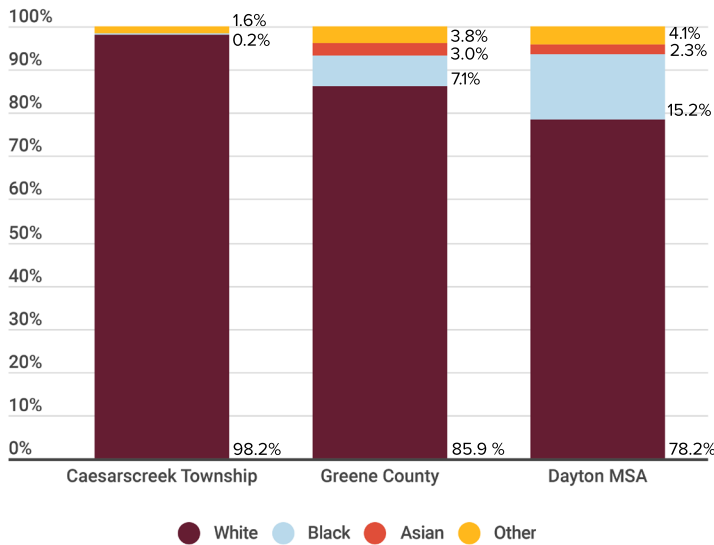

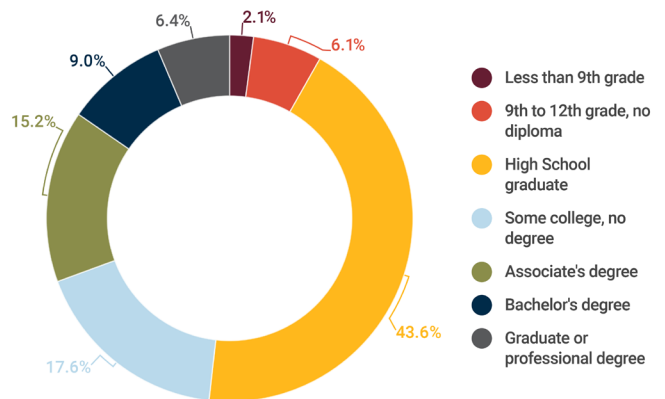

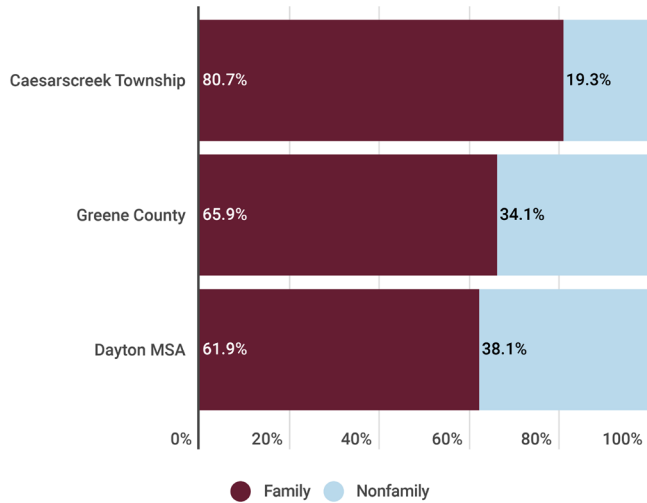

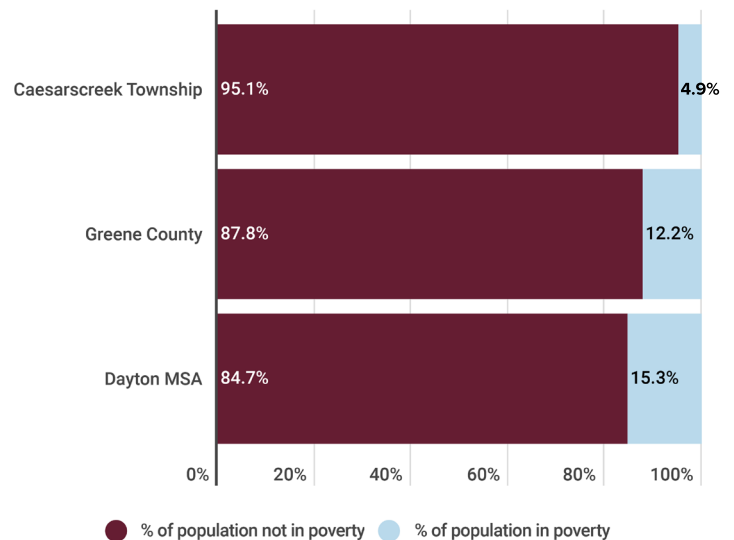

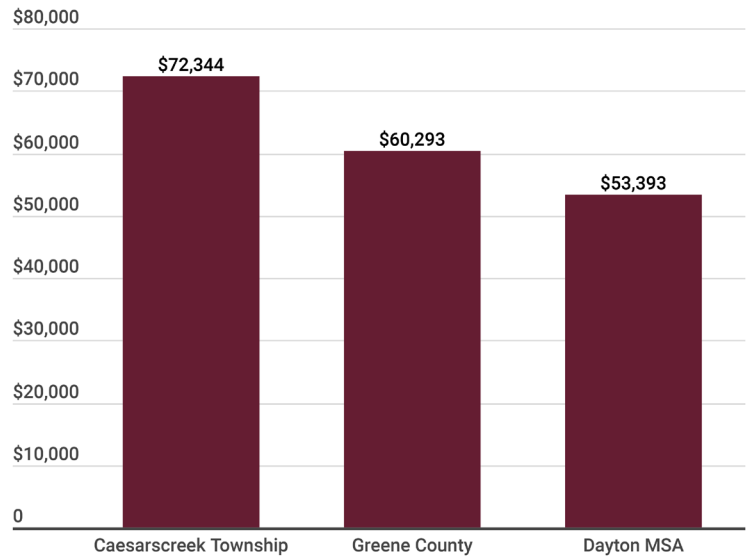

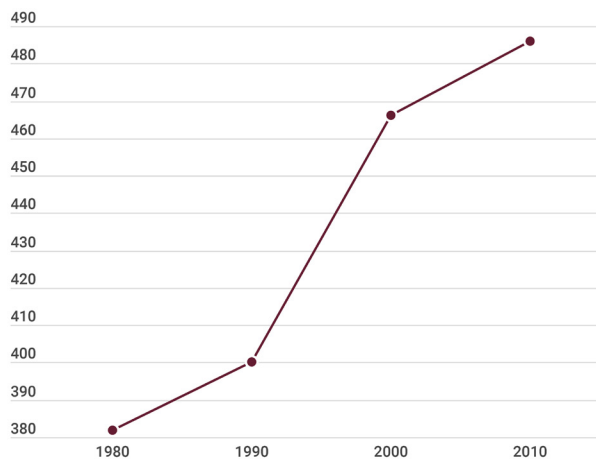

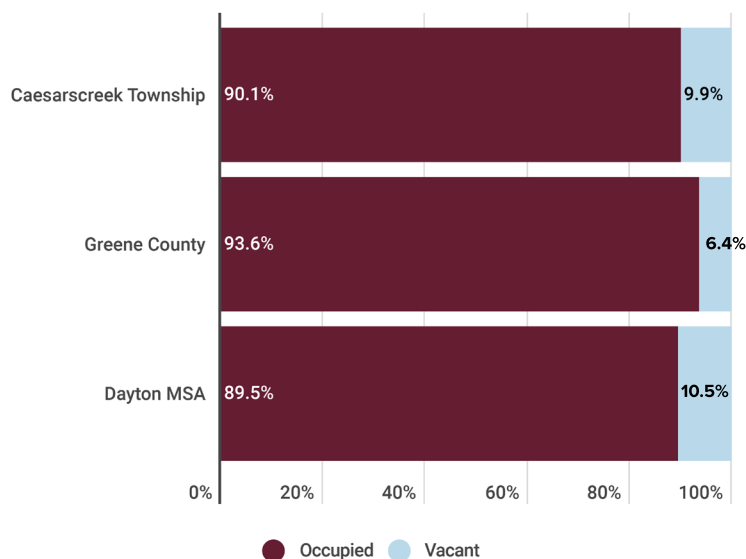

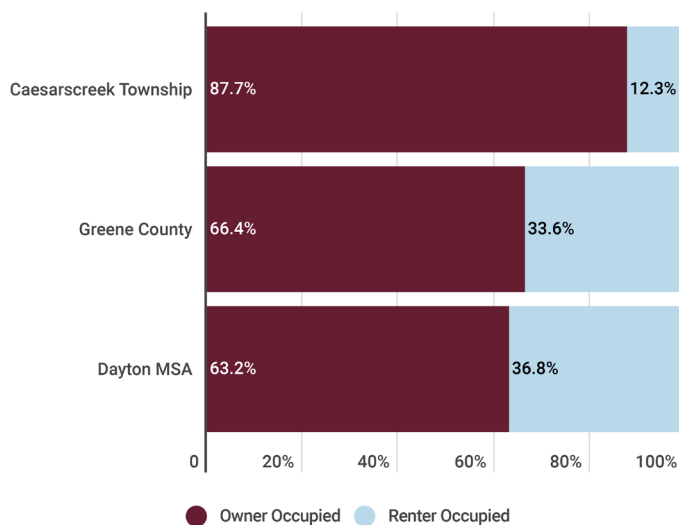

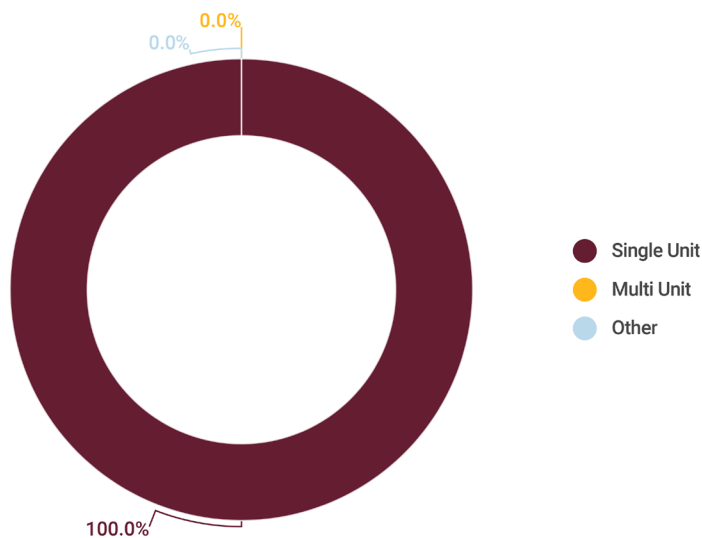

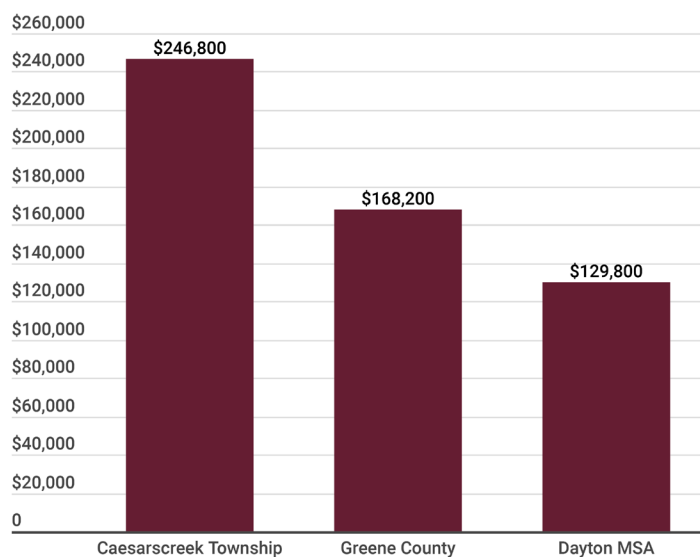

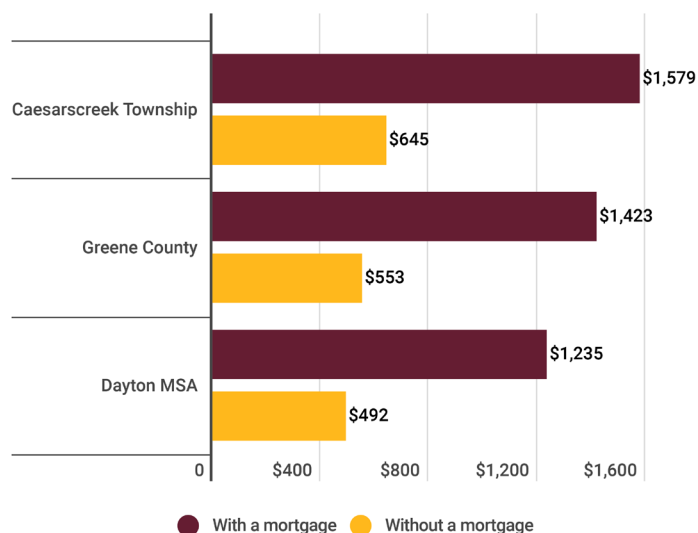

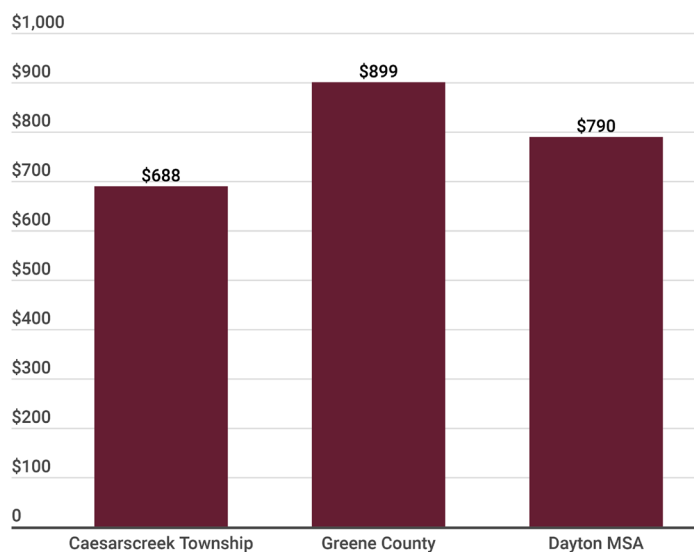

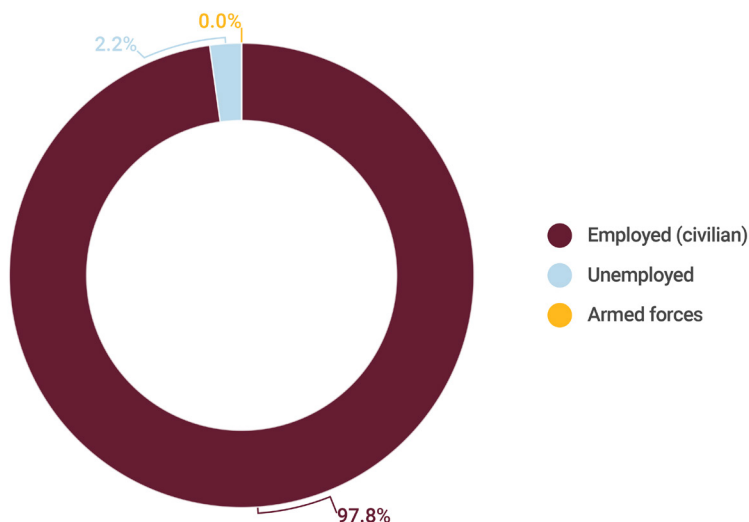
